#### Activities

In April 2015, 32 boys appeared for the Trinity Rock and Pop vocal examination, London. Mohd Humayun Abdulla scored the highest of 95 percent. The Inter House Western Music Fest 2015 for the Senior Houses was organized in the month of April. Following are the results:

To commemorate the sacrifice of great Indian martyrs in the struggle of Indian Independence, a music concert was organized by the South Western Command of the Indian Army on 13 August 2015 at Albert Hall Museum, Jaipur. A troupe of 82 boys along with other Army bands performed in the concert to excellence. 'Brave Heart', a Native American melody was especially dedicated to the great Indian martyrs.

'Sursangam' a music fest was hosted by Mayo College, Ajmer from 24-25 Aug 2015. The Arpeggios (School Rock Band) stood 3rd in the

western band category.

On 6th Sept 2015, a music concert jointly with the MCGS was presented for the Bhutanese Delegation of School Principals under a programme of Ministry of Education, Bhutan. The Arpeggios (School Rock Band) gave a scintillating performance of their fusion band and vocal solo.

To commemorate the Golden Jubilee Celebrations of the 1965 Indo-Pak War, 'Indradhanush', a carnival was organized by the Indian Army and Ministry of Defence on 20 Sept 2015 at India Gate, New Delhi. A troupe of 88 boys gave an overwhelming performance. 'Brave Heart' a Native American melody was dedicated to the great Indian martyrs. 'Matsuri', a Japanese melody and the 'Cup Song' were thoroughly enjoyed by the audience and were performed twice on special demand.

To celebrate the prestigious JTM Gibson Quiz and Debates 2015, a rock concert was performed by the Arpeggios (School Rock Band). The performance was thoroughly enjoyed by the visiting teams.

From 22 - 24 Oct 2015, an All India IPSC Cultural Fest for music, drama and literature was hosted by Daly College, Indore. Western band stood 1st in the western group instrumental category and Niket Mehra stood 2nd in the western vocal solo category.

On 6 Nov 2015, a short musical program was presented for the German delegates at Mayo College Junior School.
