Activities

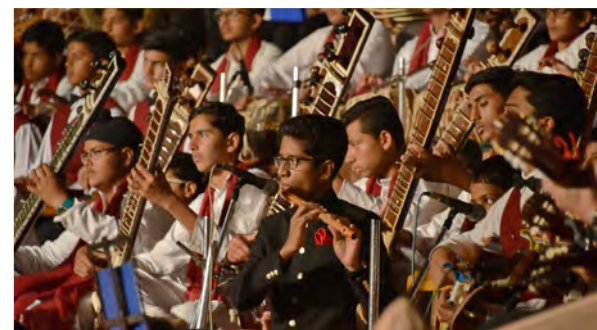
