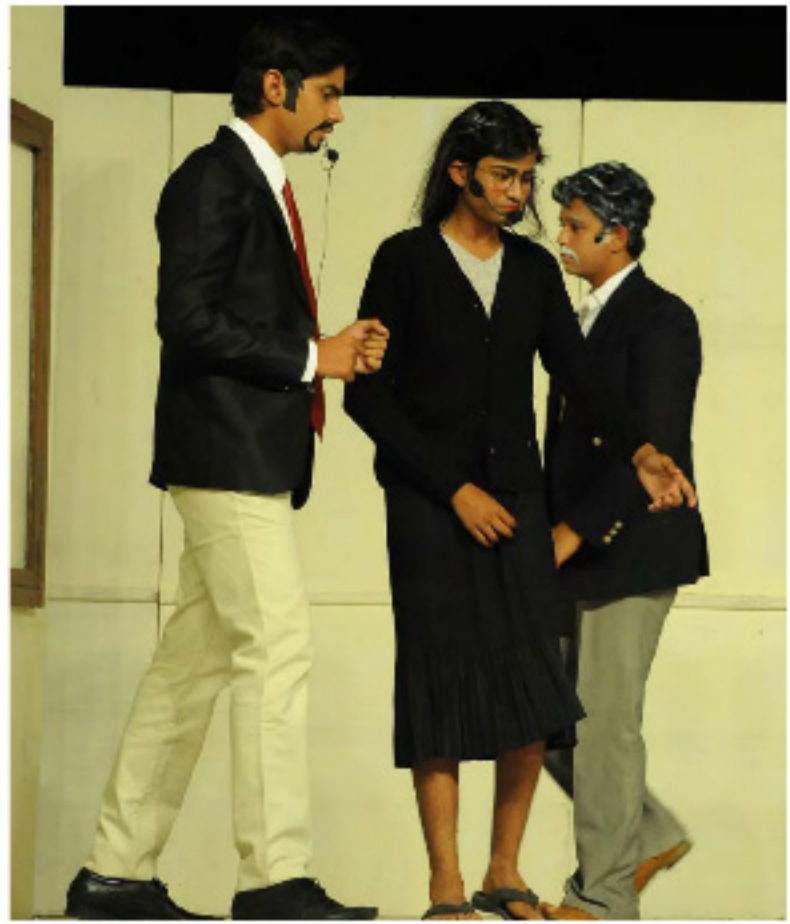

In the sphere of sports, Bharatpur House did well and won the Inter - House Cricket in 2015 and for excellent performance in Cricket, the House lifted the Portman Cup at the Prize Giving, 2015. This year as well Bharatpur House stood second in the Inter - House Cricket in the Middles category and Nilay Kumar was declared the 'Best Bowler'. Bharatpur House also saw determination and strength from its boys in the Inter - House Cross Country.
