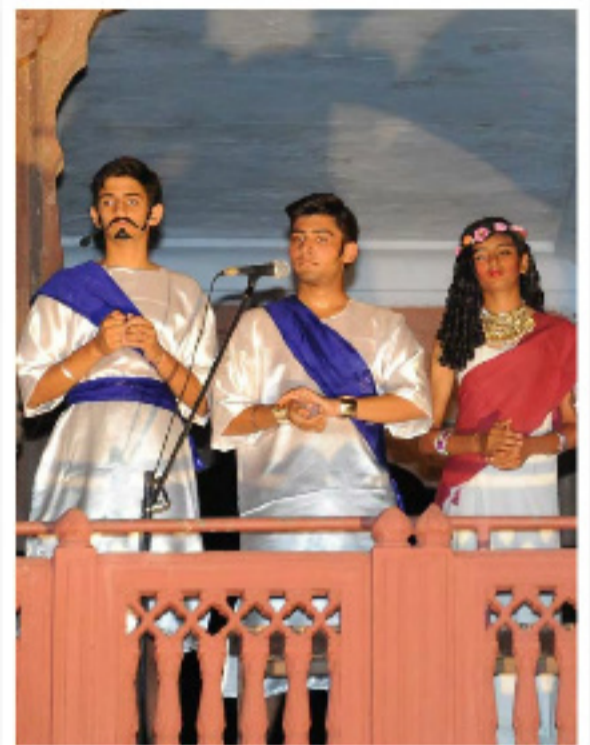

Three months of dedicated practice and hard work was enough to get applauded for honouring our eight year old streak for victory by securing the 1st position in Middles and 2nd in Seniors for the Inter - House Cross Country. Raj Maitreya and Arjun Sheoran in Middles along with Anubhav Mahdev and Manraj Sirohi in seniors were the ones who made it possible by securing individual positions. The riders of Jaipur house have made us very proud this year by winning twenty medals all together. Hartesh Singh Hara won four medals whereas Vinayak Khokar bagged 5 of them. Rochak Sobti 's exemplary performance came to light when he won eleven medals and two Best Rider's Trophies at the Delhi Horse Show and the Junior Equestrian

Nationals. Our Basketball Team in Middles lifted the Basketball trophy. Arjun Sheoran was adjudged the Highest Scorer of the tournament and led our team to victory. He also participated at the IPSC where the team stood second and he further qualified for the SGFI nationals for Basketball. Fourboys from our house, Sarmad Yar Khan, Rananjay Singh, Adit Bhadada and Gurfateh Singh Khosa took part at the IPSC Hockey Tournament and other invitational tournaments, as well. Adit Bhadada and Gurfateh Singh Khosa also moved on to play at the State and National Tournaments, respectively. In Shooting, Padmanabh Singh Rana won the IPSC Gold Medal and was qualified for the SGFI Nationals. Manraj Sirohi and Dinesh Hassani both won medals at the IPSC tournaments and later played at the Nationals.
