Sangma won a silver medal at the IPSC Shooting Tournament. Yashovarman Singh Chandel participated in the North Zone Shooting Championship and qualified for the Nationals and won a bronze medal in the IPSC Shooting

Tournament. Abhyudaya Agarwal represented in State-level Athletics Tournament and also set new record in the Inter House Athletics meet 2015 in Discuss throw. Rahul Roy won two gold medals, two silver medals and a bronze medal in All Indian Public School Conference Athletics Meet 2015 at Punjab Public School, Nabha where he was adjudged as best Athlete of tournament. He also set new record in the Inter House Athletics meet in high jump and 110 meters hurdles in senior category. Pranaav Parrth won 3 Best Speaker Awards at the Revd. Samuel Slater Memorial Invitational English debates at Bishop Cotton School, Shimla; was awarded a Special Award by Headmaster Bishop Cotton School titled "Courage in the face of Adversity"; won 6 Best Speaker (4 Pool Stages, 1 Semi Final and Finals) and one Most promising speaker at the 59th Chucker Butty Memorial Debate at The Doon school, Dehradun. He captained the Mayo College Debating team which won the 59th Chucker Butty Memorial Debates at the Doon School Dehradun after 59 years; won the Second Prize in the Turn Coat Debate at the All India IPSC Cultural Fest. Pranaav was adjudged the Best Delegate in Model United Nations conferences at Mayo College Girls' School for three consecutive years from 2013 to 2015. He was appointed President of School Debating Society and Mountaineering Club and Secretary of Economics and History Society. Shivam Mahaur secured third position in silver jubilee quiz and represented school in various debating and quizzing competition. The house secured the second position in inter-house play by staging "Le Le" - a satire on existing educational system. The uniqueness of the play was that entire house
